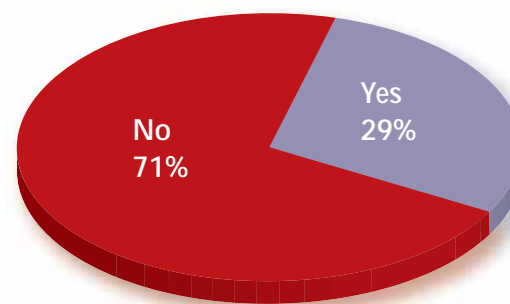


# Medication Reconciliation

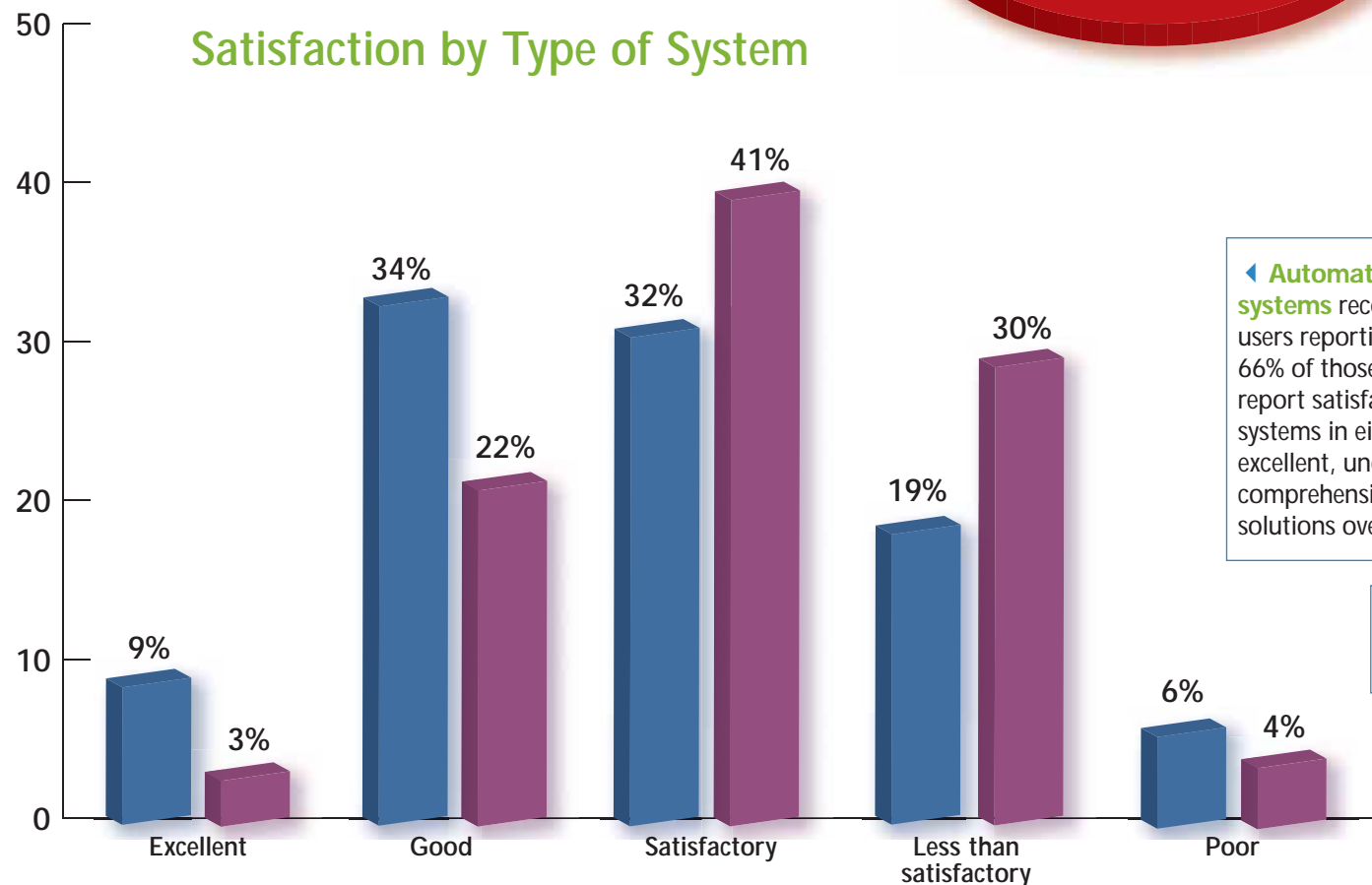

## Automated Systems in Place



While the vast majority of health systems have a formalized process for medication reconciliation in place, those taking an automated approach are still in the minority.

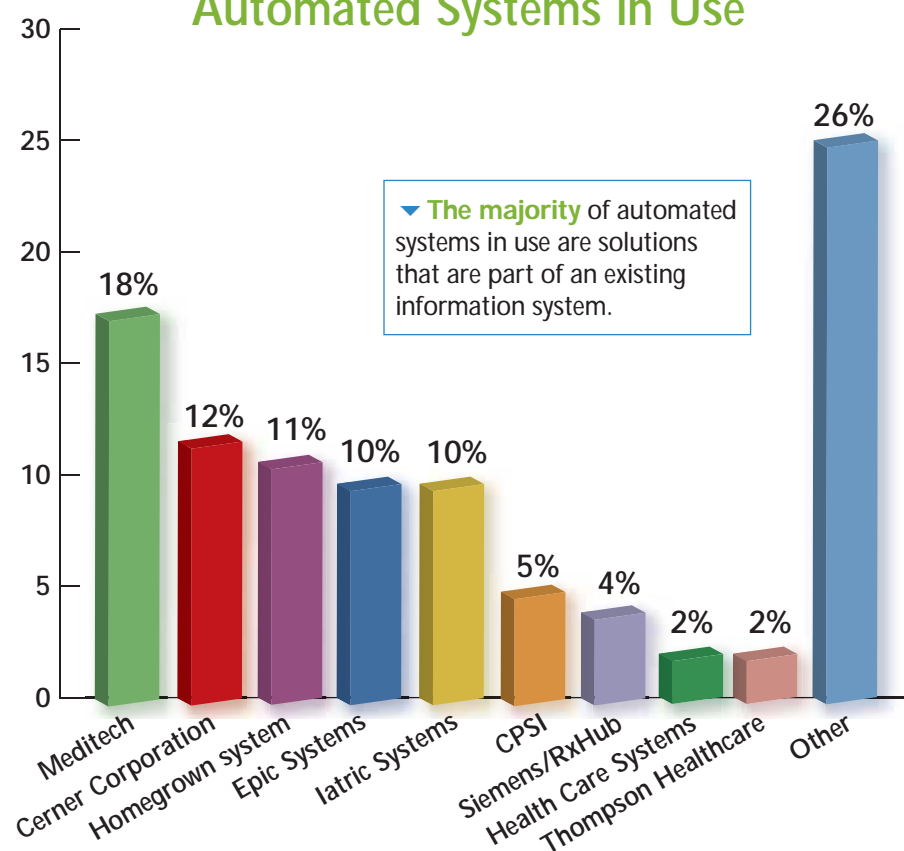
## Satisfaction by Type of System



Automated medication reconciliation systems receive higher marks, with 75% of users reporting satisfaction. In contrast, just 66% of those using non-automated systems report satisfaction. However, very few systems in either category are rated as excellent, underscoring the need for more comprehensive medication reconciliation solutions overall.

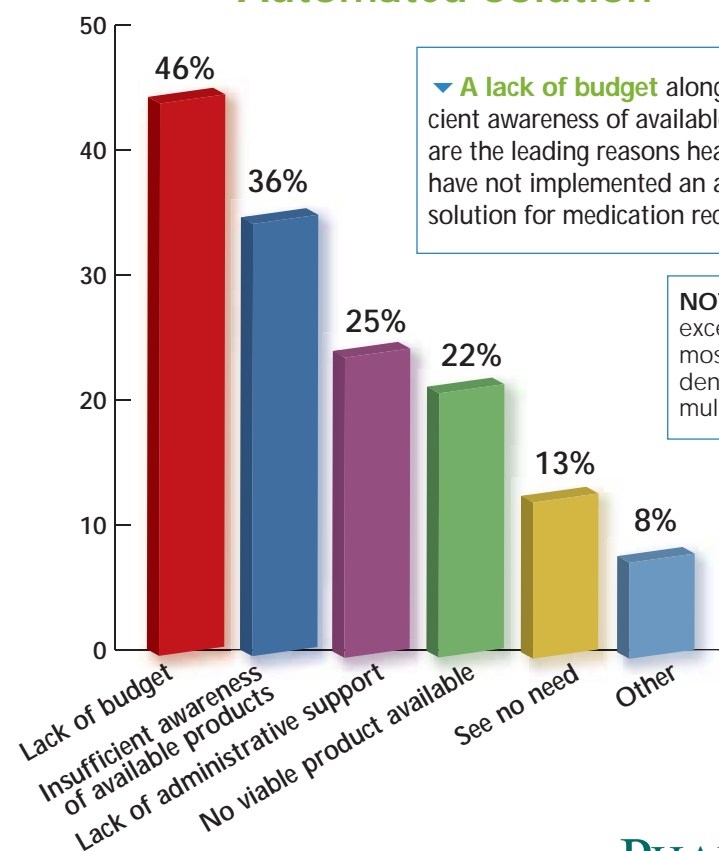
KEY: Type of system

## Automated Systems in Use



The majority of automated systems in use are solutions that are part of an existing information system.

## Reasons for Lack of Automated Solution



A lack of budget along with insufficient awareness of available products are the leading reasons health systems have not implemented an automated solution for medication reconciliation.
