


Automated Compounding Devices

The use of automated compounding devices continues to be focused mainly on larger facilities, with hospitals of 400 beds or more seeing a 9% increase over last year. 
▲ Baxa continues to lead this marketplace, followed by Baxter and B. Braun.

User Satisfaction




▲ Automated compounders enjoy very high satisfaction rates, with 80% of users giving them top marks.
